

Keep your Arizona Income Tax in the Prescott Community!!

Contribute up to \$421 as a single person, or up to \$841 as a couple, to the Prescott Noon Lions Foundation and **GET A TAX CREDIT** (not just a deduction) for the full amount of your donation on your Arizona income tax. The Lions then use 100% of the money donated to help people in our local community.

Married residents filing jointly or single residents or heads of household can take a **TAX CREDIT** on donations up to \$841 or \$421, respectively, **which can be subtracted dollar-for-dollar** from their Arizona State Income Tax liability. This charitable tax credit is **in addition to the other Arizona tax credits**, such as the Schools tax credit. If you must take a required minimum distribution from your IRA, please consider making a qualified charitable distribution to lower your Federal taxes. Consult your tax advisor.

100% of your contribution goes back to Prescott area citizens in need.

Contributions can be made up to April 15, 2024 and can be claimed on your Arizona 2023 return.
