School Vision Screening



Prescott Noon Lions (PNL) lead a program encompassing four local area Lions clubs that have vision screened more than 25,000 Yavapai County elementary school students since 2018.

Christmas Toy Drive



Since 2014, collect toys for low income children in several rural Yavapai County towns, distributed through their local community centers.

Hoodies for Vets



PNL members collect gently used and new hooded sweatshirts, jackets and coats for local area veterans.



Paper Recycling Program



PNL members collect paper, newspapers and magazines at parking lots throughout Prescott to raise money for local persons in need.

Green Bag Food Drive



PNL members form a "neighborhood" and collect food for the Green Bags food drive, every other month.

Tax Credit Details:

Married residents filing jointly or single residents or heads of households are entitled to a TAX CREDIT on donations up to \$987 or \$495, respectively, which can be subtracted dollar-for-dollar from their Arizona State Income Tax liability.

This charitable tax credit is in addition to the other Arizona tax credits, such as the Schools tax credit. If you must take a required minimum distribution from your IRA, please consider making a qualified charitable distribution to lower your Federal taxes. Consult your tax advisor.

How to Contribute:

Contributions can be made up to April 15, 2026 and can be claimed on your Arizona 2025 return. To contribute, make a check out to the Prescott Noon Lions Club Foundation and send it with your name and mailing address to:
